

## **Director of Youth and Family Engagement Job Description**

The Director of Youth and Family Engagement will develop and implement programs that will engage youth and young families within the congregation of the Robinson First United Methodist Church.

Specifically, the director will:

- Organize and guide youth groups.
- Support families in their spiritual journeys.
- Organize and implement service projects for the church's youth and families.
- Seek to integrate youth and families into all phases of the church life to create a culture that is intergenerational.
- Cooperate with other church staff to fulfill the vision and mission of the church.
- Make and maintain contact with youth and families to promote involvement in church activities.
- Utilize technology and social media to reach out to the community, employing demographic information provided by the conference to identify unchurched youth and families.
- Recruit and direct volunteers to assist with events and activities.
- Provide spiritual guidance to youth and families.
- Plan and direct youth-led worship services under the supervision of the Pastor.
- Organize mission opportunities for youth and families.
- Assist the worship team during worship services.
- Organize Vacation Bible School.
- Bring an evangelical approach to this position.
- Generally assist in other church ministries under the direction of the pastor.
- Embrace the policies and doctrines of the United Methodist Church.
